#### The Remnant of Israel

<sup>1</sup>I ask, then, has God rejected his people? By no means! For I myself am an Israelite, a descendant of Abraham, a member of the tribe of Benjamin. <sup>2</sup>God has not rejected his people whom he foreknew....

<sup>13</sup>Now I am speaking to you Gentiles. Be it done for you as you desire." And her daughter was healed instantly.




# Service of the Sacrament

Take, drink; this is the true blood of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, shed for the forgiveness of your sins.


